

**Preparation of Small Modules on Rapid Urbanization, Drinking Water, Sanitation and Waste Water Management and Organize Training Sessions for Diverse Stakeholders; and Dissemination through Mass Media and Social Media:**



**Background:** The haphazard and unplanned urbanization has led to various problems related to potable water availability, sanitation and waste water management. Therefore, there is great need of capacity building, sensitization and education of diverse stakeholders on various issues associated with ever increasing urbanization.

**Purpose:** The project is aimed to interact with all stakeholders and wider community on water centric, eco-sensitive urban planning and water and waste water management. Such trainings, interaction and dissemination would be reflected in governmental policies and ensure participation of citizens which in turn ensure the planned and water centric urban and peri urban development.

**Participants:** NGOs, Experts, People in Government, Elected Representatives in Udaipur, Rajasthan.

**Expected Outcomes:** The activity will include discussion on issues related to urbanization, water and waste water with the community, experts and the government authorities. The user friendly and easy to imbibe small modules will be produced and capacity building workshops will be organized. The social media, print media and electronic media would be used for dissemination. Three Small Modules on the subject namely (i) Eco Centric Urbanization, (ii) Water Centric Urbanization and (iii) People Centric Urbanization will be part of one Compendium which be developed as an output of the project. 70 urban and peri-urban wards of Udaipur district, Rajasthan consisting of 200 diverse stakeholders, experts etc. will be involved in the project process and exercise. The periodical outcome of the entire exercise will reach to almost 50,000 stakeholders through mass media; and social media.
